TIPS FOR PARENTS

1. **Blend Sounds:** Practise joining two phonic sounds to read simple two-letter words, gradually progressing to three-letter words.
2. **Sound and Read:** Encourage children to sound out each letter and blend the sounds rather than guessing the word from the picture.
3. **Build Vocabulary:** Introduce new words through stories, conversations, picture books and everyday experiences.
4. **Read Simple Words:** Encourage children to read familiar words from books, labels, toys and objects around the house.
5. **Read with Understanding:** After a short story, ask simple questions such as Who? What? Where? and encourage children to answer in their own words.

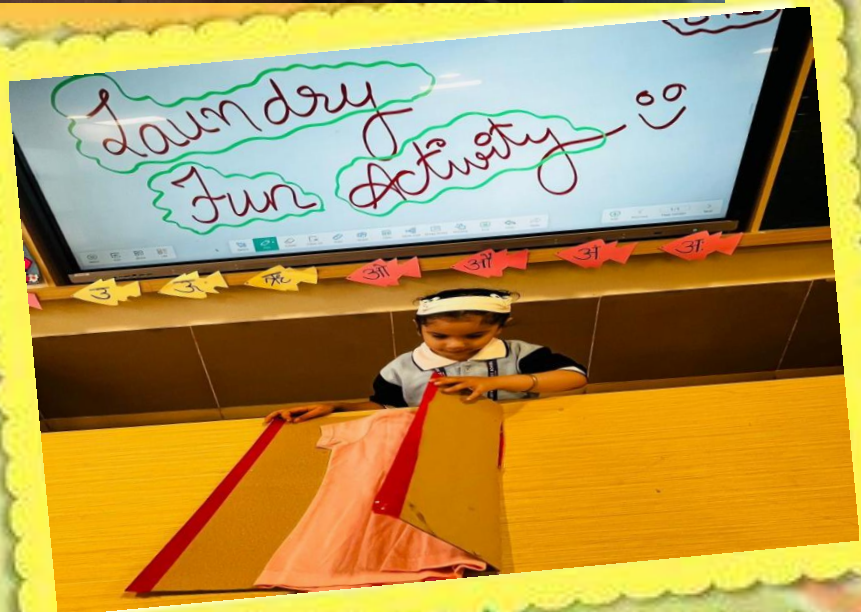
