Welcome to our joyful May Month Newsletter!

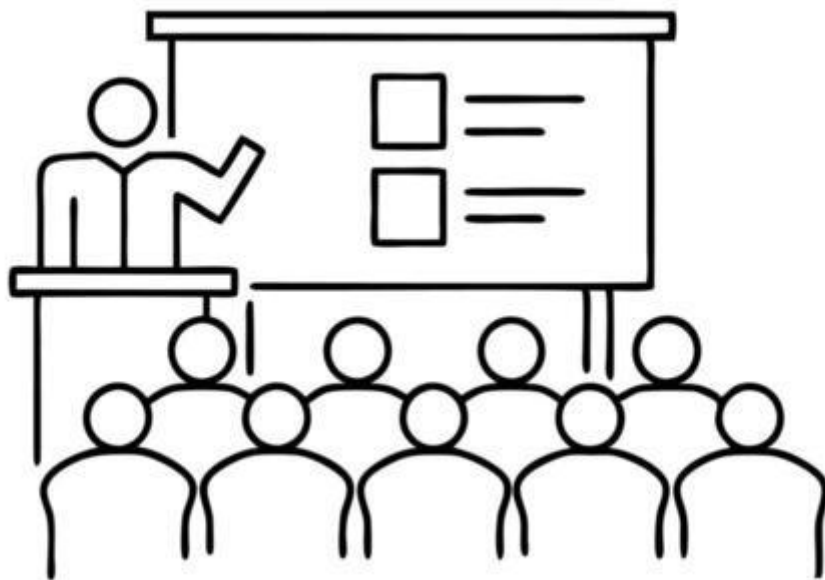
This month was full of fun, learning, and happy memories for our little stars.

MAY DAY CELEBRATION

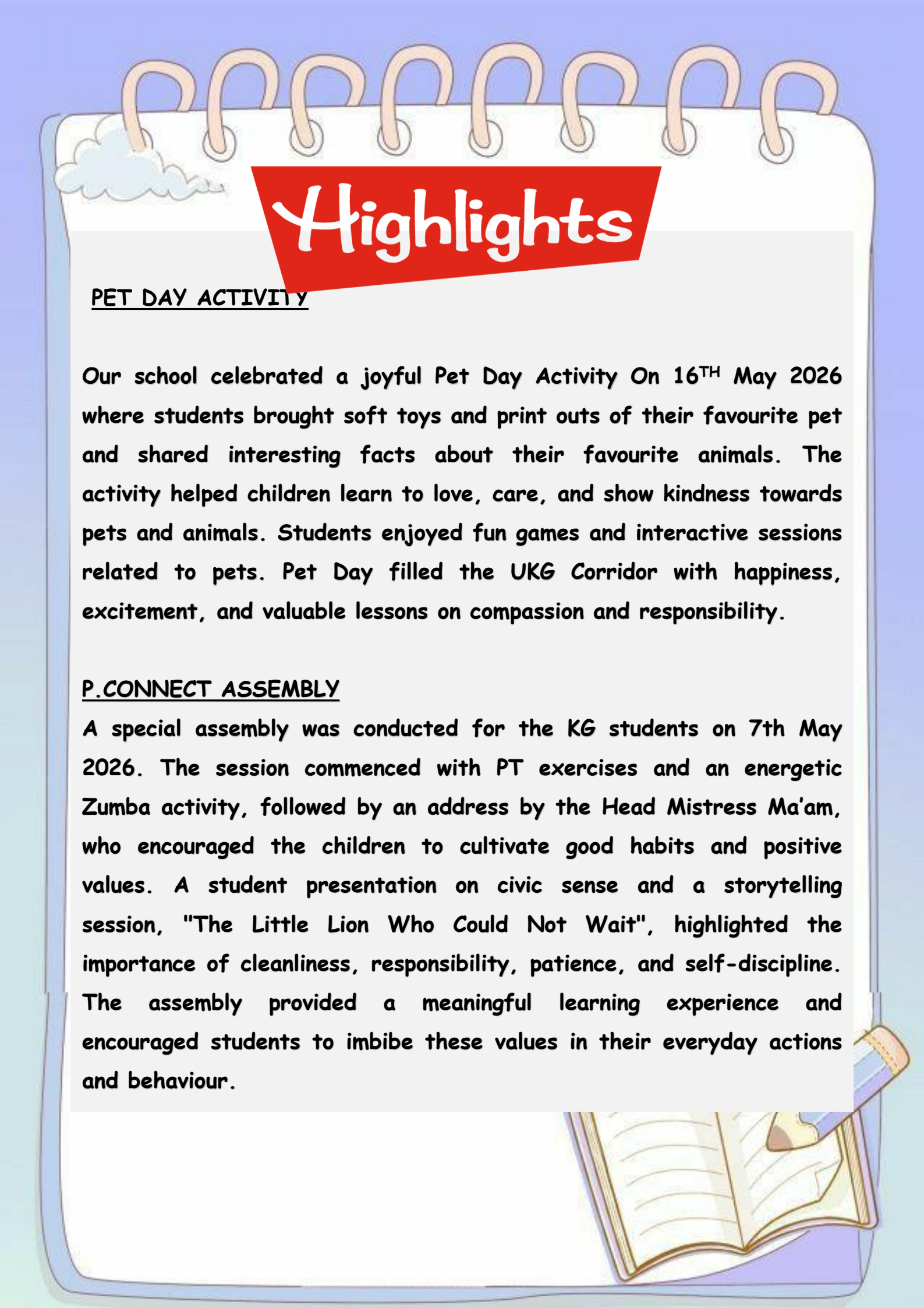

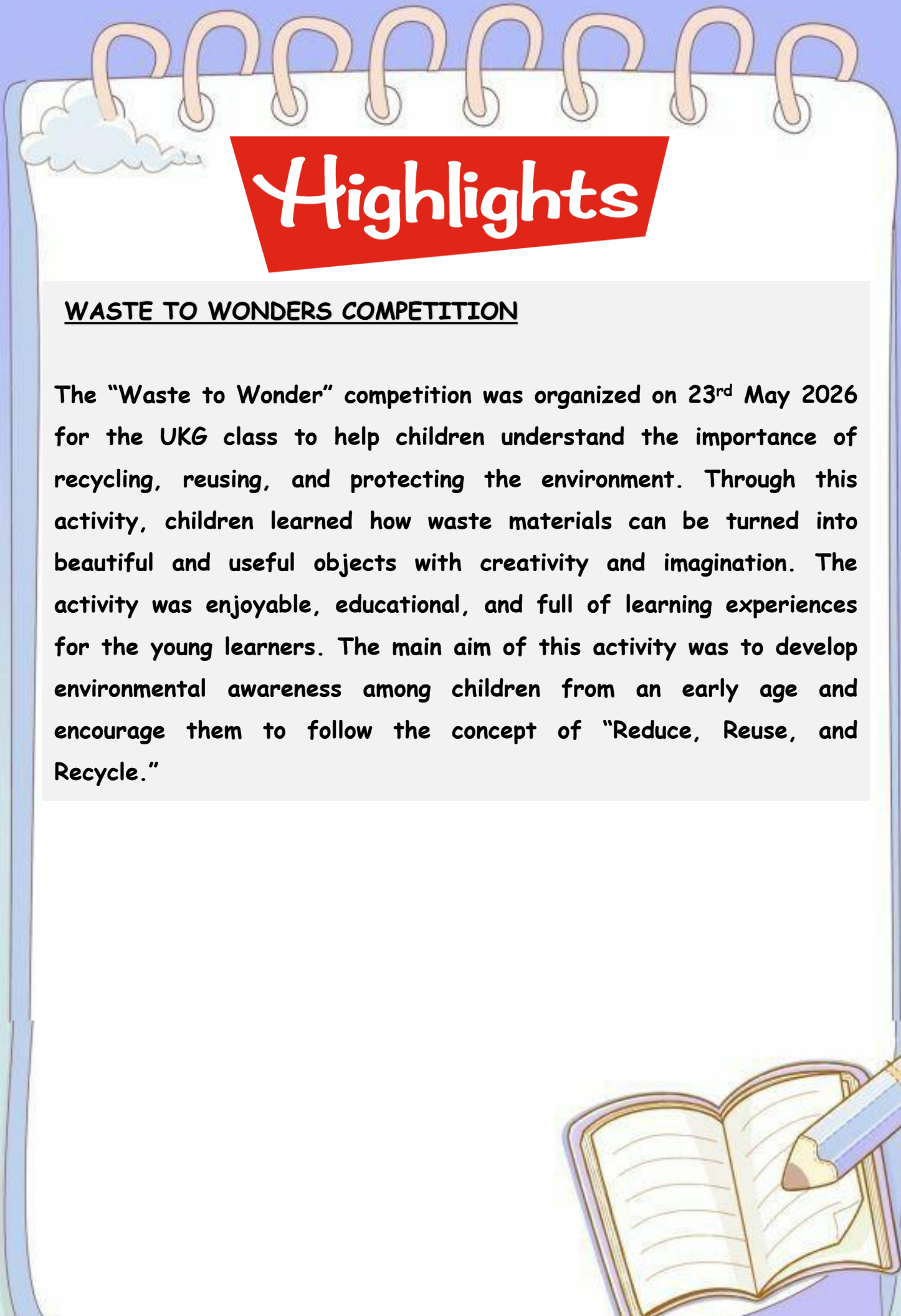
Highlights

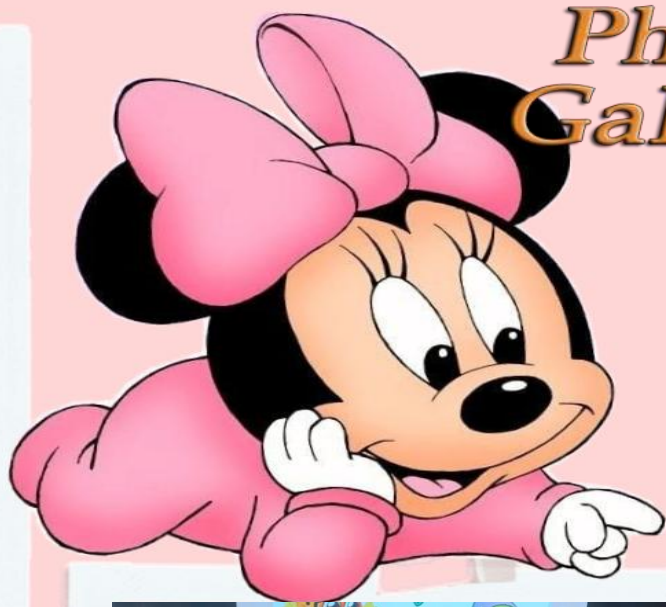
