TIPS FOR PARENTS

1. **Read Sentences:** Encourage children to read short, meaningful sentences with correct pronunciation and appropriate pauses.
2. **Progress to Paragraphs:** Gradually introduce short paragraphs and age-appropriate early readers.
3. **Read for Meaning:** Ask children simple comprehension questions and encourage them to explain answers from what they have read.
4. **Retell & Predict:** Ask children to retell a story in sequence and predict what might happen next.
5. **Read Everywhere:** Encourage children to read familiar words and signs in their surroundings—P for Parking, EXIT, STOP, shop names, labels and notices.
